

## SPECIAL REGULATIONS FOR MATRICULATION TO THE BA BUSINESS PROGRAMME

- 1 Students from the Hong Kong Baptist University who meet the following requirements shall be eligible for direct entry into Level 2 of this programme:

For students entering Level 2 in 2003/2004:

- (i) a Cumulative Grade Point Average of at least 3.0 for the associate degree programme;
- (ii) successful completion of the following modules on the associate degree programme:
  - [CS2011](#) Principles of Accounting I (Financial Accounting)
  - [CS2041](#) Principles of Macroeconomics
  - [CS2051](#) Principles of Accounting II (Management Accounting)
  - [GS0093](#) Principles of Microeconomics
  - [GS0124](#) Business Statistics
- (iii) Exceptionally, other modules may be considered in place of those listed; a minimum score of 550 in the TOEFL or 6.5 in IELTS.

For students entering Level 2 in 2004/2005 and thereafter:

- (i) a Cumulative Grade Point Average of at least 3.0 for the associate degree programme;
- (ii) completion of the following modules on the associate degree programme:
