

## MA COMMUNITY AND YOUTH WORK (L5K007)

1. Programme offered at: Durham
2. Mode of study: full-time (12 months) part-time (24 months)
3. Applicants for the programme must:
  - a) have a minimum of one year's full-time experience in Community and Youth Work or part-time equivalent, prior to admission
  - b) complete a declaration as to previous offending prosecutions since they are potentially having unsupervised, substantial access to children and young people. This requirement does not abridge the protection provided by the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act (1974) and a previous conviction would not automatically affect admission to the programme.

5. Modes of assessment for Fieldwork Practice Development will include fieldwork practice (assessed on a pass/fail basis) and written work. The numerical mark for the module as a whole will only be awarded following the achievement of a pass in the fieldwork practice element.
6. Candidates who fail to satisfy the requirements for the award of MA but who have achieved 120 credits, shall be awarded the Postgraduate Diploma Social and Community Studies (without professional qualification) as an exit qualification.
7. Candidates who fail to satisfy the requirements for the award of MA but who have achieved 60 credits, shall be awarded the Postgraduate Certificate Social and Community Studies (without professional qualification) as an exit qualification.
