2. Mode of study: full-time (12 months)
3. Students whose native language is not English must show evidence of general proficiency in the English language by normally achieving 7.0 or higher in IELTS or 600 (traditional) or 250 (computer-based) or higher in TOEFL. The former test system is preferred over the latter.
4. For the award of LLM with a named specialism, students must take at least 120 credits within that specialism including the dissertation. Any remaining credits can be acquired by taking modules from other specialisms.

6. Modes of assessment will include written examinations and assessed essays.
7. Candidates must submit by no later than 12 September 2008 a dissertation of not more than 20,000 words (90 credits), 15,000 words (75 credits) or 10,000 words (60 credits) as appropriate. Illustrative, referential and other features in a dissertation such as diagrams, tables, appendices and photographs are excluded from these word limits.
8. Candidates may apply to be allowed to resit a written examination and/or to resubmit an assessed essay in August of the year following admission to the programme.
