- 4. Before proceeding to Year 2, candidates are normally required to have passed all the taught modules at level 4 and to have passed the Research Proposal (Level 5). A candidate who fails to fulfil these requirements has the right of resubmission. If the resubmitted Research Proposal (Level 5) is also a fail, or the candidate chooses not to proceed to the doctoral thesis stage, the candidate shall be reregistered for the Research Proposal (Level 4) (ECON40160). Candidates who obtain a mark of 50% or more at Level 4 shall be awarded the degree of Master of Arts Finance Studies or Master of Arts Economics and Finance Studies or Master of Arts Management Studies.
- 5. Before proceeding to the Research Proposal (Level 5) candidates are normally required to have achieved 120 credits from their programme of taught modules at level 4 at the first attempt. Before proceeding to the Research Proposal (Level 4) candidates are normally required to have achieved 60 credits or more from their programme of taught modules at level 4 including the relevant module in Research Methods.
- 6. Candidates who fail to satisfy the requirements for the award of Master of Arts but who have achieved 120 credits from the taught modules at Level 4 shall be awarded the Postgraduate Diploma Finance Studies or Postgraduate Diploma Economics and Finance Studies or Postgraduate Diploma Management Studies as an exit qualification.
- 7. Candidates who fail to satisfy the requirements for the award of Postgraduate Diploma but who have achieved 60 credits from the taught modules at Level 4 shall be awarded the Postgraduate Certificate Finance Studies or Postgraduate Certificate Economics and Finance Studies or Postgraduate Certificate Management Studies as an exit qualification.
