YEAR 3 (Placement)

Students will undertake an approved work placement of not less than 40 weeks. From 2008/09 students will also be able to apply to spend the third year of the programme undertaking an approved study placement in an overseas university. Combinations of study and work placements will also be possible.

Student progress will be assessed at threshold level by continuous assessment of the student's performance during the placement and a final report. Assessment does not contribute to the marks used to determine the award of the degree but successful completion is required to qualify for the BA Accounting and Finance with Placement Year.
