## MA MUSEUM AND ARTEFACT STUDIES (V6K607)

- 1. Programme offered at: Durham
- 2. Mode of study: full-time (12 months), part-time (24 months)
- 3. In considering applications, a candidate's experience of museums and artefacts will carry significant weight.
- 4. The programme is designed for students who hold a first degree or other appropriate qualification and who wish to acquire knowledge and practical experience in museum and material culture studies.
- 5. Candidates are required to attend such fieldwork/museum visits/work placements as may be deemed appropriate by the Board of Studies.

- 7. Modes of assessment will include written examinations, course work or written work.
- 8. The award of MA 'with distinction' will be made to those candidates who achieve an average mark (at the first attempt) of at least 65% in modules to the value of 180 credits and the achievement of at least 70% in modules to the value of 90 credits including the Dissertation (<u>ARCH55360</u>) or Research Paper (<u>ARCH52230</u>).
- 9. Candidates in their final year must submit, by no later than 11 September 2009, a dissertation (ARCH55360) of not more than 10,000 words (excluding footnotes, appendices and bibliographies) or Research Paper (ARCH52230) of not more than 5,000 words (excluding footnotes, appendices and bibliographies).
