- 1. Programme offered at: Durham
- 2. Mode of study: full-time (12 months), part-time (24 months)
- 3. Programme of study:
  - a) All candidates must study and be assessed in the module to the value of 30 credits from Section A.
  - b) For the award of MA Music (Musicology) or (Ethnomusicology), candidates must also study and be assessed in:
    - (i) a 90 credit dissertation (Musicology) or (Ethnomusicology)
    - (ii) New Orientations in Theory and Musicology
    - (ii) EITHER a further module to the value of 30 credits from Section B OR two 20 credit modules from Level 1, 2, or 3 modules offered by the Department of Music OR exceptionally one module from Section C.
  - c) For the award of MA Music (Composition) or (Electroacoustic Studies), candidates must also study and be assessed in:
    - (i) a 90 credit composition portfolio (Composition) or (Electroacoustic Composition)
    - (ii) Compositional Techniques
    - (ii) EITHER a further module to the value of 30 credits from Section B OR two 20 credit modules from Level 1, 2, or 3 modules offered by the Department of Music OR exceptionally one module from Section C.
  - d) For the award of MA Music (Performance/Brass Band Studies), candidates must also study and be assessed in:
    - (i) a 90 credit recital (Performance) or (Bandmaster)
    - (ii) Issues in Performance Practice
    - (ii) EITHER a further module to the value of 30 credits from Section B OR two 20 credit modules from Level 1, 2, or 3 modules offered by the Department of Music OR exceptionally one module from Section C.

- 4. Modes of assessment will include practical or oral examinations and portfolio or written work.
- 5. Candidates in their final year for the MA Music (Musicology) or (Ethnomusicology) must submit by no later than 11 September 2009 a dissertation of not more than 20,000 words excluding footnotes and bibliography (90 credits).

- 6. Candidates in their final year for the MA Music (Composition) or (Electroacoustic Studies) must submit a composition portfolio by no later than 11 September 2009. The composition portfolio (90 credits) must contain: EITHER a portfolio of about 30 minutes of music (including at least 2 substantial pieces of work) OR a portfolio of about 15 minutes of music (including at least 1 substantial piece of work) and a 10,000 word written project associated with the portfolio.
- 7. For the MA Music (Performance) or (Brass Band Studies), the assessed recital will take place during either the May/June or the August/September examination period. The recital (90 Credits) must be approximately 90 minutes in duration. The commentary must be submitted at the time of the recital taking place.
