- 4. Modes of assessment will include examination and written coursework.
- 5. Candidates in their final year of the MSc must submit, by no later than 10 September 2010, a dissertation (EDUC40160) of not more than 15,000 words (including footnotes and bibliography).
- 6. Students who successfully complete modules (<u>EDUC42330</u>) AND (<u>EDUC42430</u>) OR (<u>EDUC42530</u>) and who exit the programme will be awarded the Postgraduate Certificate Educational Assessment (X9K014).
- 7. Students who successfully complete the four modules (excluding the dissertation) and who exit the programme will be awarded the Postgraduate Diploma Educational Assessment (X9K012).
- 8. Students who achieve an average mark of less than 50% in any taught module at the first attempt are allowed one further attempt to pass the module. The resit (without repeating the module itself) shall normally be at the time of the next normal assessment of the module component(s) concerned. Any alternative arrangements for re-examination shall be as specified by the appropriate examinations board (normally October and May).
