LEVEL 2 (Diploma)

1-6 Modules to the value of 120 credits chosen from List A +. Students may elect to take up to 40 credits from List B. Students may further elect, at the discretion of the Board of Studies in Law, and with the agreement of the Board of Studies concerned, to take a 20 credit module chosen from the open modules offered by another Board of Studies. The latter module may be chosen from either Level 1, 2, or 3, but if the chosen module is at Level 1 or 3, the student will thereby only be entitled to elect one 20 credit module from List B.

LEVEL 3 (Degree)

1-6 Modules to the value of 120 credits chosen from Lists B and C +. Students may elect to take up to 40 credits from List A. Students may further elect, at the discretion of the Board of Studies in Law, and with the agreement of the Board of Studies concerned, to take a 20 credit module chosen from the open modules offered by another Board of Studies. The latter module may be chosen from either Level 2 or 3, but if the chosen module is at Level 2, the student will thereby only be entitled to elect one 20 credit module from List A.

Notes:

Not all modules may be on offer in any given year.

+ By the end of Level 3 students must have taken AT LEAST ONE of the modules from List A, B or C marked with an [‡].

Students may take more than one module marked with a ‡. Students entering the programme in October 2004 and thereafter must pass at least one of these modules at 40%: the application of compensation for marks of 30-39% at Level 3 will be subject to this requirement.

In order to obtain full exemption for the purposes of legal professional qualifications, candidates must take the following modules: Public Law, Law of Obligations, Fundamentals of Land Law, Criminal Law, Trusts and Equity.

The latter module may be chosen from either Level 2 or 3, but if the chosen module is at Level 2, the student will thereby only be entitled to elect one 20 credit Level 2 Law module.
