LLB LAW (WITH YEAR ABROAD) (M103)

Programme offered at: Durham.

Mode of study: this programme is available full-time. There is no direct entry to this programme.

- This programme is available only to students admitted to the LLB Law (M101). Candidates wishing to transfer to the LLB Law (with year abroad) (M103) must:
 - (i) have successfully completed Level 1 of the LLB Law (M101) and progressed to Level 2 of the Honours or Ordinary programme;
 - (ii) during the first term of Level 2 study, apply to the Board of Studies in Law to be admitted to the LLB Law (with year abroad) (M103) and have their application approved by the Chair of the Board of Studies in Law;
 - (iii) successfully complete Level 2 of the LLB Law (M101) so as to be eligible to progress to Level 3 of the LLB Law (M101) Honours programme.

YEAR 3 (Year Abroad)

In the third year, students are required to study and be assessed in a programme of study at a European University with which the School of Law has a bilateral agreement under the LLP Erasmus Programme, or an Overseas University with which Durham University has an exchange agreement in place.

LEVEL 3 (Degree)

1-2 Dissertation LAW3022 4

Modules to the value of 80 credits, including at least 40 credits of Level 3 Law modules. Students may elect to take up to 40 credits from Level 2 Law modules. Students may further elect, at the discretion of the Board of Studies in Law, and with the agreement of the Board of Studies concerned, to take a 20 credit module chosen from the open modules offered by another Board of Studies. The latter module may be chosen from either Level 2 or 3, but if the chosen module is at Level 2, the student will thereby only be entitled to elect one 20 credit Level 2 Law module.

Notes:

Not all modules may be on offer in any given year.
