

**MA FAITH AND GLOBALISATION (L2K307)**

1. Programme offered at: Durham
2. Mode of study: full-time (12 months), part-time (24 months)
3. Candidates whose first language is not English will normally be required to possess a recent English language test score of 7.0 in IELTS or 600 in the TOEFL PBT or 100 in the TOEFL IBT.
4. Programme of study:
  - (a) Modules to the value of 120 credits from Section A. Students are required to take 30 credits from a choice of methodological modules indicated below.
  - (b) Modules to the value of 60 credits from Section B, subject to availability. Students are required to choose at least one module from Group 1 and at least one of the modules marked with an asterisk (\*\*) below, from either groups. Choice of modules must be approved by the Course Director.

7. Candidates who have failed compulsory modules may elect to be re-assessed in no more than one of those modules in September following the first occasion of assessment. The re-examination period shall take place after the dissertation submission date and therefore such candidates will not be able to submit their dissertation until the next normal occasion.
