- 1. Programme offered at: Durham
- 2. Mode of study: full time (36 months), part-time (72 months)
- 3. Candidates proceeding by full-time study must normally have at least two years of recent Christian ministerial experience.
- 4. All students will be admitted to the validated MA Theology and Ministry, offered by Cranmer Hall, Ushaw College and the Wesley Study Centre.

- 6. All candidates registered for the MA Theology and Ministry who wish to proceed to the DMin must complete modules to the value of 120 credits (which must include M401) before being considered for admission. This will normally be after two years of part-time study or one year of full-time study. Candidates will be required to provide an application with references and attend for interview to the satisfaction of the Departmental Programme Director.
- 7. Candidates who have previously been awarded the MA Theology and Ministry within eight years of their proposed entry to the DMin may be granted direct access to Level 5 of the programme. Admission will be considered upon satisfactory completion of the process described in 6 above. Candidates may be required, as a condition of admission, to satisfactorily complete further taught modules at Level 4 from those available on the MA Theology and Ministry.
- 8. Accreditation of Prior Learning (APL) cannot be granted for any of the core modules.
