POSTGRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN ACADEMIC PRACTICE (X9K814)

- 1. Programme offered at: Durham
- 2. Mode of study: Part-time (participants are normally expected to be able to complete the compulsory probationary requirement of 40 credits in 12 months. Participants can complete the full PG CAP in a minimum of 2 years or a maximum or 5 years.)

At the end of the first two modules participants may choose to:

- i. register immediately for a further 20 credit module (to be completed within 12 months) to receive the PG CAP;
- ii. register up to three years after completion of the two compulsory modules for a third module (this module must be completed within 12 months) to complete the PG CAP;
- iii. withdraw from the programme after completing the probationary requirement.
- 3. Applicants will normally be newly appointed probationary academic staff/teaching fellows at Durham University.
- 4. Successful completion of first two compulsory modules (40 credits) will enable participants to gain Fellowship of the Higher Education Academy. (*Subject to successful accreditation*.)
