LLB LAW (WITH YEAR ABROAD) (M103)

Programme offered at: Durham.

Mode of study: this programme is available full-time. There is no direct entry to this programme.

- 1. This programme is available only to students admitted to the LLB Law (M101). Candidates wishing to transfer to the LLB Law (with year abroad) (M103) must:
 - (i) have successfully completed Level 1 of the LLB Law (M101) and progressed to Level 2 of the Honours or Ordinary programme;
 - (ii) during the first term of Level 2 study, apply to the Board of Studies in Law to be admitted to the LLB Law (with year abroad) (M103) and have their application approved by the Chair of the Board of Studies in Law;
 - (iii) successfully complete Level 2 of the LLB Law (M101) so as to be eligible to progress to Level 3 of the LLB Law (M101) Honours programme.

YEAR 3 (Year Abroad)

In the third year, students are required to study and be assessed in a programme of study at a European University with which the School of Law has a bilateral agreement under the LLP Erasmus Programme, or an Overseas University with which Durham University has an exchange agreement in place.
