 c) Students wishing to take Medieval Literature Level 2 ([ENGL2031](#)) or Medieval Literature Level 3 ([ENGL3031](#)) as an option must pass at least one of: The Heroic Age ([ENGL1041](#)) or The Age of Chivalry ([ENGL1051](#)) from List A.  
 d) Not more than one Special Subject in History may be chosen in Level 3.
