1. Location: Durham City
2. Duration: Maximum of 6 months (part-time).

Admissions

3. Admissions criteria:
 - a. a minimum of three years experience in either voluntary, paid or professional community and youth work practice.
 - b. In addition, the applicant requires:
 - i) A full CV demonstrating that the candidate has experience in leadership roles in Community and Youth Work or an equivalent area of professional practice.
 - ii) Additional evidence relating to achievements in practice which demonstrates a potential to study at masters level, for example:
 - Work-based reports written by the applicant;
 - Copies of funding applications written by the applicant.
 - c. In some circumstances applicants might be required to satisfactorily complete a written exercise as a condition of acceptance.
