

**MA Education (International) (X2K207)**

1. Location: Geneva

(Students wishing to replace a Geneva-taught module with one from the Durham International Postgraduate Programme Route will need to apply to the Programme Director for permission to do so.)

2. Duration: 36 months (part-time). The programme will normally begin in October each year.
3. Candidates whose first language is not English will normally be required to possess a recent English language test score of 7.0 overall or higher (with no element under 6.0) in IELTS, or an equivalent qualification.

**Assessment, progression and award**

8. Candidates who originally registered for the award of MA Education who wish to transfer to the EdD programme must satisfactorily complete all taught modules and have satisfied a Transfer Review Panel derived from the School of Education's Board of Examiners before proceeding to the level 5 compulsory modules and subsequently submitting their thesis.
9. Candidates who successfully complete the Postgraduate Certificate in Education International (X6K214 or X7K414) and are admitted to commence the University of Durham's MA Education (International) within three calendar years of completing the Certificate will be exempted from the relevant 60 credits of the MA.
