1. Location: Durham City.
2. Duration: full-time (12 months), part-time (24 months)

Admissions

3. Admissions criteria:
 - a. Candidates must have at least near-native Arabic language ability.
 - b. Non-native speakers of English are expected to have a minimum IELTS score of 6.5 overall (with a written component of no less than 6.5), or TOEFL 573 (no less than 4.5 in the Test of Written English), CBT 230 (no less than 4.5 on the essay rating).
