Masters in Teaching and Learning (X3K007)

1. Location: Durham City

2. Duration: 36 months (Part-time).

3. The last intake of students for this programme was September 2010.

Admissions

4. The programme is available to eligible newly qualified teachers (NQTs) and Heads of Department (HoDs); in 2010 the programme was open to NQTs who gained QTS in 2008-09 and HoDs taking up posts in schools receiving National Challenge support and/or facing challenging circumstances.
