MA Risk, Health and Public Policy (L7K207)

- 1. This programme is available at Durham City, in a full-time (12 months) mode of study.
- 2. Candidates whose first language is not English are normally required to achieve an overall IELTS score of at least 6.5 and no element under 6.0. A score of 92 or above in the TOEFL Internet Based Test (IBT) and no element under 23 will also be accepted, as will an equivalent qualification. In all cases the relevant certificate should have been issued within two years of application.
