- 1. This programme is available at Durham City in a full-time (12 months) and part time (24 months) mode of study.
- 2. Candidates shall study and be assessed in the following modules:

4. Candidates shall also study and be assessed in modules from List B to complete the total of 180 credits for the programme.

- 5. Modules marked with a ~ must be passed at 50% or above; a mark of 40-49% cannot be compensated.
- 6. Candidates who select a CFLS credit-bearing language module must select 185 credits in total.
- 7. Modules marked with a * are not available in 2014-15.
