#### **Assessment, progression and award**

8. Modules marked with a # must be passed at 40% or above in order to progress to the ordinary degree at the next Level.
9. A student who is registered for the BA Accounting and Finance with Study Abroad who wishes to transfer to the MAcc Financial Accounting with Study Abroad and is suitably qualified to do so, in accordance with the Core Regulations, shall be permitted to transfer subject to the approval of the Director of Undergraduate Studies.
10. A student who is registered for the MAcc Financial Accounting with Study Abroad who wishes to transfer to the BA Accounting and Finance with Study Abroad shall be permitted to transfer subject to the approval of the Director of Undergraduate Studies.
11. Candidates who fail to achieve the standard required under the Core Regulations for progression to Level 3 of the BA Accounting and Finance with Study Abroad may progress to Level 3 of the BA Accounting and Finance in the Honours or Ordinary stream in accordance with the Core regulations.

#### **Professional accreditation**

12. Durham University Business School is accredited by the European Quality Improvement System (EQUIS) for a period of three years from 2014 and by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB) for a period of five years from 2013.
