MA TESOL (Q3K207)

- 1. Location: Durham City.
- 2. Duration: full-time (12 months), part-time (24 months)
- 3. English language requirements:

a. Non-native English speakers must have achieved an IELTS score of at least 7 with at least 7 in each section.

Programme structure

- 4. There are three streams within the programme. These provide candidates with the option of further focussing their Masters qualification by adding a particular specialism. The three streams lead to different degree titles:
 - a. MA TESOL (Q3K207)
 - b. MA TESOL (English for Specific Purposes) (Q3KA07)
 - c. MA TESOL (Young Learners) (Q3KB07)
