Postgraduate Certificate in Academic Practice (X9KH14)

1. Location: Durham City.
2. Duration: 18 – 24 Months (Part-time). Participants are normally expected to complete the 60 credit module in 18 months.
3. Applicants will normally be newly early career academic staff (teaching and research track, teaching track) at Durham University, though the program is open to professional support services staff who spend a significant fraction of their time supporting student learning.

4. Candidates shall study and be assessed in the following modules:

Assessment, progression and award

5. This programme will be assessed on a pass / fail basis.
6. Successful completion of 60-credits will enable participants to gain Fellowship of the Higher Education Academy.
7. Accreditation of prior learning for Introduction to Academic Practice is possible for those who've undertaken modules with comparable learning outcomes and/or have gained AFHEA.
