Postgraduate Certificate in Academic Practice (X9KH14)

- 1. Location: Durham City.
- 2. Duration: 18 24 Months (Part-time). Participants are normally expected to complete the 60 credit module in 18 months.
- 3. Applicants will normally be newly early career academic staff (teaching and research track, teaching track) at Durham University, though the program is open to professional support services staff who spend a significant fraction of their time supporting student learning.
