BA MODERN LANGUAGES AND CULTURES (WITH YEAR ABROAD) (R002)

Level 1 (Certificate)

1. This programme is available at Durham City, in a full-time mode of study.
2. At Level 1, each candidate must follow one of six pathways, as listed below:

Pathway 1	One language at advanced level
Pathway 2	Two languages at advanced level.
Pathway 3	Two languages at advanced level and one language at beginners' level
Pathway 4	Two languages at advanced level and Catalan
Pathway 5	One language at advanced level and one language at beginners' level
Pathway 6	Three languages at advanced level

Within each of these pathways, candidates will take modules from Lists A (Advanced Language), B (Beginners' Language), C (Context modules) and/or D (Foundation modules), according to the rules for each pathway as defined in paragraphs 6–11, below.

3. Language modules offered by the School of Modern Languages and Cultures generally have a code that begins with one of the following prefixes

ARAB	Arabic
FREN	French
GERM	German
SPAN	Hispanic Studies
ITAL	Italian
RUSS	Russian

4. At L1, each of the modules on List D (Foundation modules) is available only to students who are taking at least one language module (from either List A or List B) that has the same prefix (for example 'FREN') as this Foundation module.
5. Each of the modules on List C (Context modules) is available only to students who are taking at least one Advanced language module (List A) that has the same prefix as this Context module.

Candidates on Pathway 1 must study and be assessed in **one** module from List A (Advanced Language to the value of 20 credits; **one** module from List C (Context modules) to the value of 20 credits; and **one** module from List D (Foundation modules) to the value of 20 credits. In addition, they must study and be assessed in the following **two** modules, to the value of 60 credits:

7. Candidates on **Pathway 2** must study and be assessed in **two** modules from List A (Advanced Language) to the value of 40 credits; **two** modules from List C (Context modules) to the value of 40 credits; and **two** modules from List D (Foundation modules) to the value of 40 credits.
8. Candidates on **Pathway 3** must study and be assessed in **two** modules from List A (Advanced Language) to the value of 40 credits; **one** module from List B (Beginners' modules) to the value of 40 credits; and **two** modules from List D (Foundation modules) to the value of 40 credits.
9. Candidates on **Pathway 4** must study and be assessed in **two** modules from List A (Advanced Language) to the value of 40 credits; **one** module from List C (Context modules) to the value of 20 credits; and **two** modules from List D (Foundation modules) to the value of 40 credits. In addition, they must study and be assessed in the following module, to the value of 20 credits.

10. Candidates on **Pathway 5** must study and be assessed in **one** module from List A (Advanced Language) to the value of 20 credits; **one** module from List B (Beginners' modules) to the value of 40 credits; one module from List C (Context modules) to the value of 20 credits; and **two** modules from List D (Foundation modules) to the value of 40 credits.
11. Candidates on **Pathway 6** must study and be assessed in **three** modules from List A (Advanced Language) to the value of 60 credits; and **three** modules from List D (Foundation modules) to the value of 60 credits.
12. Candidates studying the programme on a part-time basis must take at least one Advanced or Beginners' language module during their first year of study at each Level.
13. Advanced language modules (List A) are only open to candidates with an A-Level or equivalent qualification in the relevant language at Grade B or above, and to candidates with an equivalent level of language ability. Candidates who do not have these qualifications in a particular language may be required to undergo a diagnostic test.
14. Candidates should note that Level 2 and Level 3 modules with any of the above prefixes are only available to students who have passed an advanced or beginners' language with the same prefix at the **previous** level.

Level 2 (Diploma)

15. At L2, each candidate must follow one of four pathways, as below:

Pathway 1	One language at advanced level
Pathway 2	Two languages at advanced level
Pathway 3	One language at advanced level and one 20-credit language-module at beginners' level

Pathway 4	One language at advanced level and one 40-credit language-module at beginners' level

Within each of these pathways, candidates will take modules from Lists E (20-credit Advanced Language), F1 (20-credit Beginners' Language modules), F2 (40-credit Beginners' Language modules), G1, G2, G3, G4 or G5 (20-credit Culture modules), according to the rules for each pathway as defined in paragraphs 20-24, below.

17. L2 modules with any of the prefixes listed above in paragraph 3 are only available to students who have passed an Advanced or Beginners' language with the same prefix at L1.

18. Culture modules in lists G1 - G5 are available only to students studying a module with the same prefix from Lists E, F1 or F2.
19. Candidates **on all** pathways must study at least one Culture module (Lists G1 - G5) with the same prefix as each of their chosen language modules in Lists E, F1 or F2).
20. Candidates on **Pathway 1** must study and be assessed in **one** module from List E (L2 Advanced Language modules) to the value of 20 credits; and **three** Culture modules to the value of 60 credits in total from Lists G1 – G5), **with no more than one 20 credit module selected from any single list**. All Culture modules should have the same prefix as the module chosen from List E.
21. In addition, candidates for **Pathway 1** must study and be assessed in **two** of the Exploration modules offered by the School of Modern Languages and Cultures and/or by other departments in the Faculty of Arts of Humanities. One of these must be taken from List H (Michaelmas Term Exploration modules), and the other one from List I (Epiphany Term Exploration modules), to the value of 40 credits in total:

22. Candidates on **Pathway 2** must study and be assessed in **two** modules from List E (L2 Advanced Language modules) to the value of 40 credits in total, and **four** modules from Lists G1, G2, G3, G4 or G5 (Culture modules) to the value of 80 credits in total. At least one Culture module must have the same

prefix as the first language module chosen from List E and at least one Culture module must have the same prefix as the second language module chosen from List E.

23. Candidates on **Pathway 3** must study and be assessed in **one** 20 credit module from List E (L2 Advanced Language modules); **one** 20 credit module from List F1 (20-credit Beginner's Language modules); and **four** 20 credit modules from Lists G1, G2, G3, G4 or G5 (Culture modules), with no more than one module selected from any single list, to a total value of 80 credits from Lists G1 - G5. At least one Culture module must have the same prefix as the Advanced language module chosen from list E; at least one Culture module must have the same prefix as the Beginner language module chosen from list F1.
24. Candidates on **Pathway 4** must study and be assessed in **one** 20 credit module from List E (L2 Advanced Language modules); **one** 40 credit module from List F2 (40-credit Beginner's Language modules); and **three** 20 credit modules from Lists G1, G2, G3, G4 or G5 (Culture modules), with no more than one module from any single list, to the total value of 60 credits from Lists G1 - G5. At least one Culture module must have the same prefix as the Advanced language module chosen from List E; at least one Culture module must have the same prefix as the Beginner language module chosen from List F2.

Year 3 (Year Abroad)

25. During their year abroad, full-time candidates intending to study only one language in their final year are required to spend a period of residence of no less than 7 months in a country/countries speaking this language.
26. Candidates intending to study two languages in their final year are required to spend a period of residence of no less than 7 months in total, spending at least 4 months in one country and at least 90 days in the other country whose language they are studying.
27. Part-time candidates are required to spend at least 4 weeks in each country whose language they wish to study at Level 3. These 4 weeks may be spread over the duration of the programme.
28. Candidates who do not fulfil the residency requirement will be transferred to R004 Modern Languages and Cultures, at the end of the academic year.

Level 3: Degree

29. At L3, each candidate must follow one of four pathways, as listed below:

Pathway 1	Any one language, except Arabic
Pathway 2	Any two languages, except Arabic
Pathway 3	One language, which is Arabic
Pathway 4	Two languages, including Arabic

30. Within each of these pathways, candidates will take modules from Lists J (20-credit Language modules), K (20-credit Applied Language modules), L1, L2, L3, L4, L5, or L6 (20-credit Culture modules), according to the rules for each pathway as defined in paragraphs 31-36.

In addition to the dissertation, candidates on **Pathway 1** must study and be assessed in **one** 20 credit module from List J (L3 Language modules); **three** 20 credit modules from Lists K, L1, L2, L3, L4, L5, or L6 to the total value of 60 credits. All Applied Language (List K) and Culture modules (Lists L1 - L6) must have the same prefix as the Language module chosen from List J. Candidates must never choose more than one Culture module from any single list.
33. In addition to the dissertation, candidates on **Pathway 2** must study and be assessed in **two** modules from List J (L3 Language modules) to the total value of 40 credits and **two** modules from Lists K, L1, L2, L3, L4, L5, or L6 to the value of 40 credits. **One Culture** module must have the same prefix as their first Language and one Culture module must have the same prefix as their second Language module. Candidates should never study **more than one Culture module from any single list**.
34. In addition to the dissertation, candidates on **Pathway 3** must study and be assessed in ARAB 3012 to the value of 40 credits. Candidates must also study **two** modules from Lists K, L1, L2, L3, L4, L5, or L6 to the value of 40 credits. All Culture modules must have the prefix ARAB. Candidates must never study more than one Culture module from any single list.

Candidates on **Pathway 4** must also study and be assessed in **one** module from List J (L3 Language modules) to the value of 20 credits; and **two** modules from Lists K, L1, L2, L3, L4, L5, or L6 to the value of 40 credits. One Culture module must have the same prefix as their first Language and one Culture

module must have the same prefix as their second Language module. Candidates should never study more than one Culture module from any single list.

37. L3 modules with any of the prefixes listed above in paragraph 3 are only available to students who have passed an advanced or beginners' language with the same prefix at L2.

Assessment, progression and award

38. Modules marked # must be passed at 40% or above in order to progress to the next level of study.
39. Modules marked with ~ must be passed at 40% or above for the award of an honours degree. A mark of 30-39% cannot be compensated.
